**Y**es, this would have been the weekend that we celebrated The Amazing American Penny Carnival! A summer tradition begun by Fr. Krizner in 1980 and for 7 years it continued on the grounds of St. Columbkille Church. Then in 1985 when he was assigned to Holy Name HS, the AAPC lay dormant (**CLOSED FOR THE SEASON**) until it reopened here at St. Colette in 2007! Among our most famous visitors to the Carnival was Bishop Pilla and the AAPC attracted visitors from all over the area. The theme was always **AMERICA!** -with a sub-theme of **EUCLID BEACH PARK**. In the 80's, Fr. K met Edward Chuckayne, one of the authors of the Euclid Beach Books. In his kindness he gave Father a number of items from the Park—including an original 8 track of Laughing Sal which we displayed each year. The Carnival was a plethora of Memories—good old fashioned fun for a nickel, dime even a penny!





Upon entering the Amazing American Penny Carnival you were greeted by the continual laughter of Laughing Sal as you passed through arches made by Tom Mason. The arches were a copy of the originals which still stand on Lake Shore Boulevard.

Once inside the American theme flowed through the entire hall—and often enough there were special guests—including Benjamin Franklin, Martha Washington, Dolly Madison and unforgettably even Laughing Sal herself! (Ruth Landreth)

## EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

### Being Human is to Doubt

Humans doubt. It's what we do. We doubt ourselves and we doubt others.

Before any of us say anything about Peter's doubting the words of Jesus that told him he could get out of his boat and walk on water, we need to get real with ourselves: How would I respond in the same situation? I remember when I was child taking swimming lessons. One day I simply tightened up my muscles and sank. The lifeguard pulled me up and asked what happened. I said I did not know. The truth is that I was sinking under the weight of my own doubt. I did not believe I could do what clearly, I was told I could. That was only in five feet of water in a pool! Now that I'm older, I can look back and laugh. But as an adult, the swimming pool is life, and I would be lying if I said that there are no longer times I find myself sinking due to new doubts.

Much of our doubt comes about because of a lack of trust in God. We place our trust in material things, wealth, or imperfect people instead of the One who is worthy of our trust 100 percent of the time. Our stewardship is often hampered by our doubt that God will provide all that we need. If I give more, I may not have enough to survive! When we place all our trust in God, not only do we find that we have been given all we need – our doubt that cause us to sink in the pool of life fades away. We don't suddenly become perfect in our trust, and there will be times when we find ourselves with concerns again. However, it is in those moments we find that He is still there, speaking the words we need to hear: "Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid."
