A little different this year, but here are the details of this favorite family event:

- Reservations are a must and will be taken for a 20 minute time-slot from 11am-2pm. There will be a maximum of six families in the hall for each 20 min slot. As a result, it is imperative that you arrive on-time.
- As you walk through Christmas Village there will be six stations where children will receive treats, participate in safe, hands-on activities, take photos, visit with Santa, and conclude with a visit to our parish Nativity scene—all with Santa's elves to guide you along your journey. Only one family will participate in a station at a time, giving each an opportunity to have fun and feel comfortable.
- Children are encouraged to bring their letters for Santa, and WILL be able to visit with him at a 6-foot distance.
- There is no limit to your family count, but we ask that you be considerate of other families. Masks are required, with the exception of picture-taking.
- Reservations will start beginning the weekend of November 14th/15th after all of the Masses and will conclude once all of the time-slots are filled. Don't delay!
- This is a FREE event with donations gladly accepted at the door.
