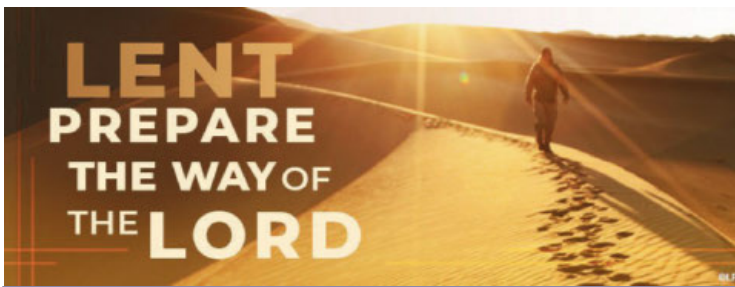




We Adore You, O Christ...

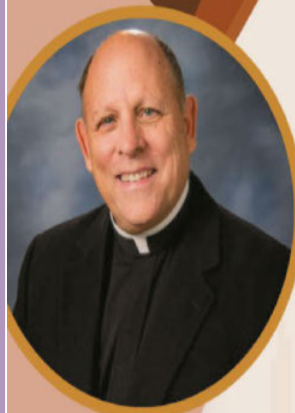
