GOSPEL MEDITATION

March 17, 2024
5th Sunday of Lent

A middle-aged woman sat on the couch in my parish office and recounted to me a shocking list of terrible calamities in her life: addictions, terminal illnesses, financial loss, broken relationships, and so on. She smiled as she did so. "Please forgive me," I asked, "but you seem to be smiling as you share this." She said, "Father John, I am totally overwhelmed. But I'm smiling because I just can't wait to see what good things God does with this mess." She expected God would manifest His glory when she most needed it.

This week in the Gospel, God speaks from heaven for the third and final time in Jesus' earthly ministry. It's at a tough moment. Gentiles seek Jesus, who announces his terrible suffering, and then boldly prays, "Father, glorify your name!" John then writes: **Then a voice came from heaven, "I have glorified it and will glorify it again."** Was the task of drawing the whole non-Jewish world to himself overwhelming? Or was it the terrible specter of crucifixion? Whatever it was, the crushing weight triggers his turning to the Father with an unshakeable *expectation* of divine glory to burst through. And indeed, it did on Easter Sunday. In our burdens, our greatest strength is to turn to God and boldly ask Him for His glory.

Lenten challenge: This week, I invite you to list out everything which is a burden to you. Write it down. Then add these words: "Father, glorify Your name in all these things!" Put that paper in your pocket or purse when you come to Holy Week liturgies next week. You might smile at the most unlikely times.

Today is Passion Sunday!

Last weekend, Laetare Sunday, we "rejoiced" in our sufferings, fast, and prayer in the joy that we've passed the halfway mark of Lent. That passing, however, brings about the reality of the dark days of Holy Week to come. That's why you'll notice the statues covered in purple and the crucifix in red... that soon we'll recall the days when the earth trembled and moaned as the world crucified their God...

The days are coming, says the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and house of Judah. It will not be like the covenant I made with their fathers the day I took them by the hand to lead them forth from the land of Egypt; for they broke my covenant, and I had to show myself their master, says the Lord. No longer will they have need to teach their friends and relatives how to know the Lord. All from least to greatest, shall know me, says the Lord, for I will forgive their evildoing and remember their sin no more.

Fun Facts about St. Patrick you may or may not know!

- March 17th is his feast day! He died on this day in 461 AD
- Patrick wasn't Irish! He was Scottish, but captured as a slave to Ireland. It was in his 12 years in captivity that he grew closer to God, hearing his call for something greater to come...
- He used familiar imagery and relatable concepts to convert Ireland from a pagan country to devoutly catholic, like the shamrock to teach the Trinity... though note that no imagery can truly depict it... it's one of those great mysteries of our faith!!
- The "snakes" he drove out of Ireland are symbolic of the paganism and false worship drove out of the country... how he the Lord used one man to change an entire country— one that became a model for catholic devotion for centuries. Just think of how he uses you!

GOLDEN ROSE, QUEEN OF IRELAND

There's nothing quite like the assuring look of a mother to her child. So often the depths of a child's deepest needs is fulfilled not in anything she has to say, but through her eyes, her soul of love. The beautiful Catholic Hymn, Lady of Knock, describes the apparition in County Mayo Ireland on August 21, 1879 where our Blessed Mother's gaze toward heaven gave those witnesses that very same profound peace. Mary, dressed in a beautiful, white garment with a crown of gold on her head, appeared to a group of townspeople from children to the aged. St. Joseph was on one side of her and St. John, who appeared to be preaching, on the other. Then on an altar beside the trio, a Lamb. For two hours people marveled at her beauty and piety, praying aloud the rosary for the duration of time she remained on that rainy August day. Mary never spoke a word. She only held her hands raised and opened in front of her with her eyes fixed toward heaven. The hearts of those who experienced the miracle that day didn't need words from Mary to be assured of her love. For at her very presence alone all their "cares and troubles ceased" in a beautiful moment of peace. Lady of Knock, our queen of peace, pray for us!~ Sara



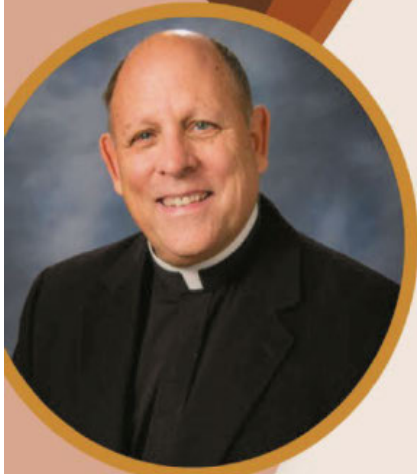
